## Background



#### Existing Agreements ending June 2023

- All MOUs for Ongoing Annual Programs
  - These MOUs are used to formulaically allocate Measure A sales tax revenue.
- Neighborhood Shuttle Grant Agreements
  - The first round of funding utilized accumulated funding from the prior 10 years and the annual revenue anticipated through June of 2023
  - SacRT's SmaRT Ride Program
  - ParaTransit's Moving Youth to Jobs Program
